«Turkmenistan, possessing some of the world's largest hydrocarbon reserves, has successfully developed its oil and gas sector. These achievements contribute to the country's economic and sustainable development, aligning with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

Turkmenistan actively supports the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals. Significant for the oil and gas sector are SDG 7 (affordable and clean energy), SDG 9 (industry, innovation, and infrastructure), and SDG 13 (climate action). The country aims to increase the share of clean energy, implement innovative technologies, and minimize environmental impact.

One of Turkmenistan's priorities is reducing methane emissions, one of the most harmful greenhouse gases. The country cooperates with international organizations such as the United Nations Environment Programme and the Global Methane Pledge. Using advanced technologies and emissions monitoring allows Turkmenistan to control and reduce pollution levels effectively.

In recent years, Turkmenistan has successfully implemented several major projects to develop new oil and gas fields. One example is the Galkynysh field, the largest onshore gas field in the world. Developing such fields increases the country's export potential and ensures stable revenue, which can be invested in social and infrastructure projects.»

Achievements and Perspectives

Turkmenistan is a major player in the Asian oil & gas market. The country's hydrocarbon resources are estimated at over 71 billion tons of oil equivalent, that is over 20 billion tons of oil and over 50 trillion cubic meters of natural gas. Given these figures, as of today, Turkmenistan holds the world's fourth-largest proven natural gas reserves after Russia, Iran, and Qatar. Currently, Turkmenistan's largest customer is the People's Republic of China. Turkmenistan also supplies gas to Uzbekistan and will soon start supplies to Iraq.

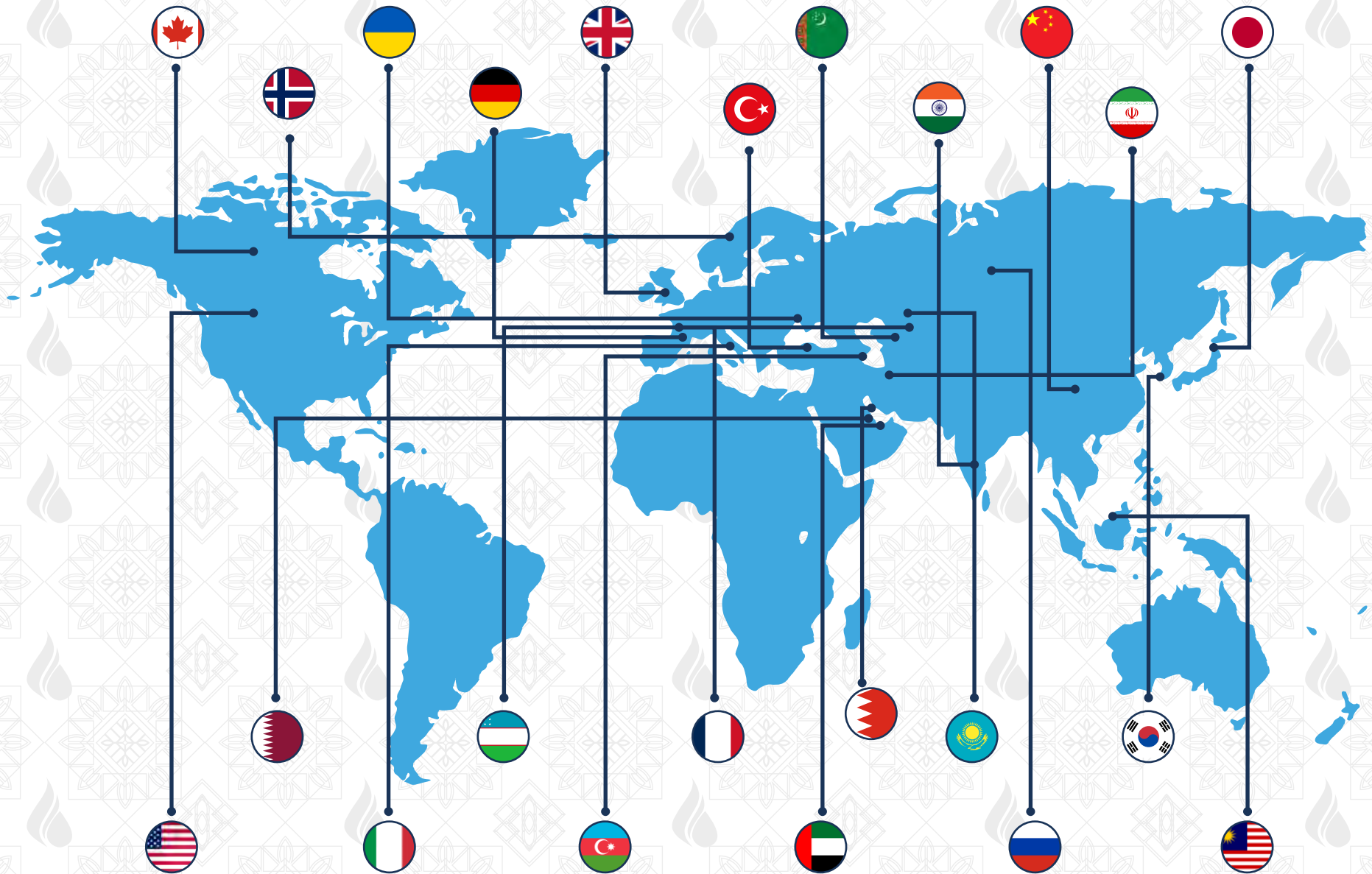

ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERSPECTIVES

Turkmenistan is proceeding with the Turkmenistan-Afghanistan-Pakistan-India (TAPI) gas pipeline project. On September 11, 2024, the construction of the Serhetabat-Herat (Afghanistan) section of the TAPI gas pipeline was launched. The 1,853-km pipeline will deliver up to 33 BCMA natural gas from the Galkynysh gas field in Turkmenistan to three off-take points in Afghanistan, three off-take points in Pakistan, and a final off-take point at the Pakistan-India border to supply the Indian market.

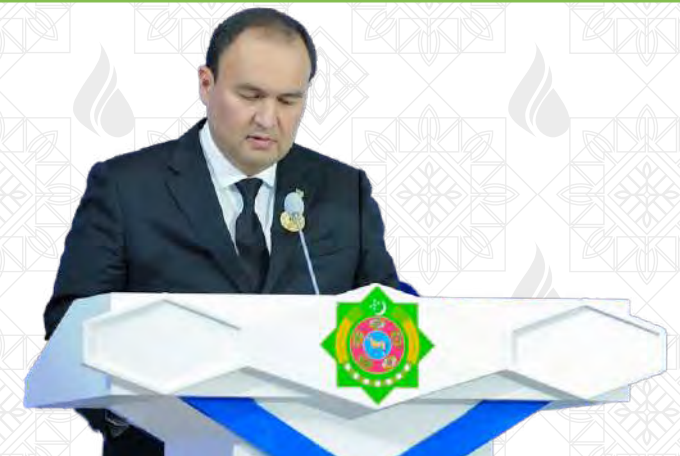



Currently, several leading IOCs are producing oil and gas from contractual areas in the Caspian Sea: ENI, Dragon Oil, Petronas, and others. The focus of this year's Conference will be the attraction of investment to offshore blocks, optimization of production from mature fields, and the next phase of development of the supergiant Galkynysh field, the largest onshore gas field in the world.

UNDERGROUND GAS STORAGE & GEOTHERMAL ENERGY: OVERVIEW OF THE BEST INTERNATIONAL PRACTICE

Most of the world's underground gas storage facilities (UGS) are located in depleted fields. These fields already have all the necessary production infrastructure in place, which reduces initial investment costs. UGS gives producers flexibility during significant seasonal fluctuations, when natural gas consumption is highest in winter and lowest in mild weather months. UGS allows gas to be delivered in line with demand on any day throughout the year and increases the efficiency of gas exports. As SC "Turkmengas" is currently considering the option of using one of the depleted gas reservoirs as an underground storage facility, this session will review international best practices in the field of UGS and discuss technical and economic aspects. A special focus of the session will be on utilizing geothermal energy towards a low-carbon future.

ENVIRONMENTAL ASPECTS IN THE PRODUCTION OF HYDROCARBON RESOURCES: FOCUS ON REDUCING METHANE AND CO₂ EMISSIONS

Turkmenistan, with its vast hydrocarbon resources, aims to minimize the environmental impact of its oil and gas operations. Turkmen experts have achieved a significant reduction in emissions at Darwaza crater through the implementation of modern forced gas extraction techniques. According to research data from Capterio, the volume of natural gas emissions has decreased by half this year. The session will focus on emission reduction strategies and technologies, best practices in sustainable resource management and the role of the regulatory framework in enhancing environmental responsibility. The session aims to emphasize environmentally friendly practices and show Turkmenistan's commitment to sustainable development and global environmental goals.
